The German Embassy School Addis Ababa (DBSAA) is supported by the "German School Association in Ethiopia" and is accredited as an Excellent German School Abroad, which looks back on a history of more than 90 years of outstanding achievements in the field of education. More than 300 students are cared for in a family environment by around 100 dedicated staff to nurture their potential from nursery and kindergarten through elementary school to grade 12. Outside of the classroom, we have a dynamic school community that brings together parents, alumni and teachers. As a German international school, we immerse students in the German language, history and culture and provide an environment where children develop into empathetic, self-directed and critical thinkers. At the same time, we explore perspectives from Ethiopia, a country rich in historical heritage and cultural diversity.

Scope of activities

For many students, the DBSAA is a central place where they not only learn but also form social bonds and develop a sense of togetherness within the school community. Grades 1 to 6 are offered educational after-school care with the aim of promoting the individuality of each child and creating a space in which they can exercise and strengthen their autonomy and self-competence. The development of a positive culture of debate and discussion is encouraged through equal interaction with one another. The afternoon care provides time and space for movement, creativity and activities that meet the individual needs and potential of the children. The afternoon program is conducted in German and supported by internal and external activities.

- Supervision in grades 1-6
- Homework supervision
- Guidance and supervision during play and leisure activities
- Active participation in the design and implementation of various activities (e.g. creative activities, arts and crafts, sports, nature, music or technology clubs)
- Supervision during lunch together
- Participation in school events and projects
- Collaboration with the elementary school teachers
